



SEPR-8[™] Release Agent

SEPR-8[™] is a petrolatum based sealer-release agent formulated specifically to release **Aqua-Resin[®]** casting/laminating products from either plaster or from cured **Aqua-Resin[®]** itself. It also maybe used as a release agent for rigid polyester molds.

Application

Apply to a plaster or **Aqua-Resin[®]** mold, (the mold can be either “green-wet” or dry). Using terrycloth, or a similar fabric, apply the **SEPR-8[™]** working it well into the “grain” of the mold. Then, using a second, clean piece of terry cloth, rub off the **SEPR-8[™]** leaving a thin film.

Repeat the above procedure for a second time. Then proceed as usual, applying the **Aqua-Resin[®]** mix to the mold.

Please note: Use no more **SEPR-8[™]** than necessary to achieve a satisfactory release; excess can cause “pocketing” of the gel coat and will decrease release properties.

The use of a sealer before application of SEPR-8[™] is not recommended.

TIP

Working with rigid molds requires that the cast part have no undercuts. Also, extra cure time may be desirable to ensure a stronger part before demolding.

*Please Note: The use of **SEPR-8[™]** with Latex rubber molds is not recommended.*
